## **Presentation of the Conference**

The conference in Florence with its theme *Which lighting to the historic cities Unesco* will be an opportunity to promote, with proofs and proposals, a reflection and a comparison for a correct use of artificial light, according to the characteristics of the historical centers and monuments, also as a result of the gradual introduction of LED technology.

The use of light as an element of use of space and quality of perception in urban planning or landscaping area can be analyzed in its specific use and various purposes.

It is the bond of artificial light with the environment as a whole that needs to be studied in depth indeed, for a correct reading and interpretation of what we intend to look and how to intervene toits perception and its protection.

The artificial lighting design of the sites must be specific and targeted to their main function, but above all it must catch the viewer's expectations in respect of the object to be lightened.

Artificial light has to respect the place, integrate with it, giving value to the specific characteristics and to the influence of changes of light and darkness on the same places.

The conference in Florence will try to emphasize these elements declining themin four specific aspects to be explored:

- The promotion and exaltation through the light of the beauty of the place.

- The balance of lighting and its integration with daylighting.

- The promotion through the light of the lesser known monumental corners.

- The application of new technologies (programming and lighting computerization).
